


## *Baptism of the Lord Prayer*


(If you wish to participate in the reaffirmation of your baptism, please have a small bowl of water available as we worship; we will use the liturgy on the other side of this insert.)



## *Reaffirmation of the Baptismal Covenant*



The Lord Be With You.  
**And also with you.**
